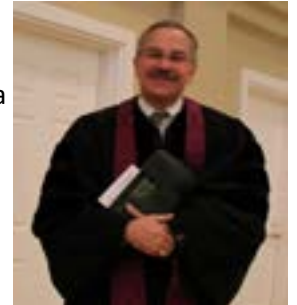
A Message From the Desk of the Rev. Dr. Dave Melton
