Each Sunday we highlight Christian symbols (sometimes visible in our Sanctuary, sometimes meaningful to the season) to deepen our understanding and enhance the worship experience for everyone, young and old.

There are two sets of **three steps in the Chancel** in our chancel which represent faith (top step), hope (middle step), and love (bottom step). (I Corinthians 13. 13) Notice that the cross on the altar (called the Calvary or Graded Cross) has the same three steps. The three steps may also be seen as a Trinitarian reference, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
